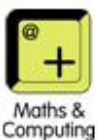

PUNCTUALITY Please ensure your child is in the school playground by 8.30am for lessons at 8.40am. Students late to school will be given a detention on the day. Students have been instructed that they are NOT to 'hang around' the



school gates before and after school. In the mornings they should be in the playground, after school they should go straight home.

ABSENCE	If your child is absent from school please contact the school informing us on the day of the reason for the absence. On return to school your child needs a note from you to the tutor explaining and confirming the absence.
HOMEWORK	Three subjects per evening, 45 minutes per subject per evening.
STUDENT DIARY	Parent/Guardian please sign on a weekly basis.
UNIFORM	All students are to adhere to our school uniform rules (trainers, hooded tops and caps are banned items). Winter coats/jackets/scarves must be dark in colour with no logos.
EQUIPMENT	All students should have a pencil case, black/blue pens x2, pencils x2, ruler, rubber, sharpener, compass, protractor, calculator, coloured pencils, appropriate school bag.
APPOINTMENTS	If your child has a medical/dental appointment may we ask that this is made after school, if it is necessary to make an appointment during school time please inform your child's form tutor in writing and if possible in advance.
